It has been a different year for the executive committee in 2020/2021 due to the continuation of Covid 19.

Since the last AGM your committee has been continuing with meetings via zoom and we have completed a number of tasks in the background.

Our Breed Education Coordinator ran a Breed Appreciation Day as per the Kennel Club requirements, we filled all the available spaces and this covered the costs of the platform, conference room and certificates. We had a presentation delivered by Penny Westaway & Helga Edmondson, we then had Tiago Fortuna from Portugal for questions and answers at the end. We had 30 participants who attended and completed the online question paper, we had 28 with 100% and 2 with 98%, our reviews on the day provided us with excellent feed back and were extremely positive in the responses.
